Mishele Vieira, CPO[®], is the owner of Away With Chaos, Inc., and will speak on the topic "Get Organized-Clear Out the Clutter." Vieira has been organizing individuals, families, and companies for more than 20 years, focusing particularly on people experiencing life transitions, and working with older adults and people with brain-related conditions that make it difficult to get and stay organized. In 2007, she became one of the first to earn the official Certified Professional Organizer designation.

The Westchester Mental Health Guild is a 501(c) (3) organization which has for the past 61 years worked to raise funds to support Airport Marina Counseling Service. Among other activities, the Guild operated a gift shop called "the Guided Cage" from 1975 through 2016, and conducted 37 annual indoor tours of homes decorated for the holidays in Westchester and Playa del Rey. When the pandemic began, the Guild began to hold mostly online events, including wine tastings, cooking and flower-arranging demonstrations, and a trivia contest. In addition, the Guild hosted a popular Holiday Lights Tour & Contest in 2020-2022, as well as selling handcrafted items and hosting restaurant fundraisers.

One such fundraiser occurs January 29 through February 2 at Tony P's in Marina del Rey. Tony P's will provide 20% of the bill to the Guild from all diners presenting a coupon that can be found on the Guild's website, at www.westchestermhg.org.

The funds the Guild raises support the AMCS clinic at 7891 La Tijera Boulevard, which provides affordable mental health counseling to the community and also trains therapists.
