Just in time for Valentine's Day, the Westchester Mental Health Guild will host a virtual sparkling wine tasting, on Thursday, February 10, 2022, at 7 p.m. Certified Sommelier Bill Priestley will be conducting an online session comparing a California brut sparkling wine with a brut Champagne from France.

Tickets for the fundraiser are \$90 per couple or per computer monitor, and are sold through Eventbrite www.sparkling.eventbrite.com. The ticket price includes a bottle of Napa sparkling wine, and a bottle of Champagne, an assortment of John Kelly gourmet chocolates, and suggested food pairings. Each customer will pick up the wines at Airport Marina Counseling Service (AMCS) before the event. Only 50 tickets will be sold.

Bill Priestley, who will conduct the evening's festivities, is an account manager for Southern Glazers Wine & Spirits. He is also a witty and engaging wine expert who is a member of the AMCS Board of Directors. He will share his extensive knowledge of the wines, the regions in which they were grown, and how to store and serve them. The evening will also include a live auction for gift baskets filled with a variety of spirits, wine, and related items.

The Westchester Mental Health Guild is a 501(c) (3) organization, now in its 60th year, that raises funds to support AMCS, which operates a local clinic to provide affordable mental health counseling to the community and also to train therapists.
